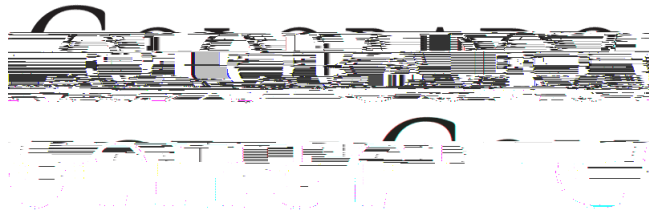

## Freedom of Expression

As a private institution, Colorado College is a voluntary association of persons invited to membership with the understanding that they will respect the principles that govern the college. Freedom of thought and expression is essential to any institution of higher learning. Uncensored speech — which does not include a right to harass, injure, or silence others — is essential in an academic community and will be vigorously defended. Members of the college community should understand that standards of civility, consideration, and tolerance must shape our interact



disciplinary sanctions on members of the college community who violate college policy.

**(b) Demonstrations:**

Demonstrations by members of the campus community may occur on campus, but must not disrupt the regular operation of the college. Given that, the college reserves the right to control the time, place, and manner of events that occur on campus.
