Here are some of the most commonly asked uestions regarding campus' sexual discrimination or harassment policy and plocedures:

What are some examples of sexual Harassment?

Inappropriate behavior may include: +

- Unwanted flirtation, advances, or propositions
- Pressure for sex
- Leering
- Display of sexually suggestive objects visuals
- Display/transmission of sexually suggestive electronic content
- Any unnecessary, unwanted physical contact
- Sexual assault (if this occurs, call the police immediately and maintain evidence)

### What should I do lif I feel I have been sexually harassed?

- Document the problem behavior: date, time, place, witnesses, specific behaviors
- Tell the harasser that the behavior is offensive and that you want it to stop
- Seek counseling and personal support from the Office of Counseling and Fsychological Services.
- File a complaint incomplaint procedures

### What about false allegations?

Sanctions may be imposed on individuals who knowingly, or with reckless disregard for the truth, make fallse accusations of sexual harassment. Just because a complaint cannot be proven does not mean that it is false.


