IT IS on _____, 2018 **ORDERED** as follows:

1. It is declared that Essex County College and Karen Bridgett are in violation of OPRA and the common law right of access in failing to provide access to the records requested by Plaintiffs;

2. It is declared that Essex County College and Karen Bridgett are in violation of OPRA in failing to indicate a specific basis for their refusal, failure, or inability to comply with the requests made by Plaintiffs;

3. Essex County College and Karen Bridgett are ordered to immediately grant Plaintiffs access to all of the requested records in unredacted form;

4. Plaintiffs are entitled to an award of attorney’s fees and costs of suit, and shall submit any bill of costs or petition for attorney’s fees by _____,
2018;

5. This Court will maintain jurisdiction over this action until Essex County College and Karen Bridgett come into compliance with this Court’s directives and orders; and

6. Plaintiffs shall serve a copy of this order upon Defendants within _____
days of the date hereof.
