WHEREAS, Faculty Senate adopted a Resolution on April 4, 2019 (the "Resolution") regarding Free Speech Expression on Campus and f rwarded the Resolution to Interim President John Green ("Interim President Green") f r a consideration and response; and

WHEREAS, Interim President Green f rwarded the Resolution to the Of ce of General Counsel, which reviewed and approved the Resolution as to legal f rm and sufciency; and

WHEREAS, Interim President Green also fravarded the Resolution to the Ofce of A cademic Afairs, which sent the Resolution to University Council frits consideration and response; and

WHEREAS, The University Council endorsed the Resolution by unanimous vote at its meeting on May 28, 2019, and

WHEREAS, Interim President Green now has f rwarded the Resolution f r consideration by The University of A kron (the "University") Board of Trustees (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, The Board firmly supports academic fieedom and fiee speech on campus and has incorporated those ideals in to University Rule 3359-44-01 and in Article 9, "A cademic Freedom, Rigits, and Responsibilities" in the collective baigaining agreement between the University and the Akron Chapter of the American Association of University Profissors, and
