Your letter dated February 22, 2011, to Steven Lee Johnson, President of Sinclair Community College, has been referred to me for response. In your letter you express concerns about Sinclair's policy regarding distribution of literature by students on campus, as set forth in the Student Code of Conduct.

You may not be aware that Sinclair also has a Campus Access Policy. Section IV of the policy, which applies to employees, students, and recognized student organizations, the policy is enclosed and is also available on Sinclair's web site at www.sinclair.edu/about/offices/bus/campusaccess.

The Campus Access Policy, which is attached, provides for a policy that permits students to exercise their first amendment rights in a manner that is not disrupted. Sinclair remains committed to being a place where students, faculty, and visitors can exchange ideas in ways which enhance the educational process.

Thank you for giving Sinclair the opportunity to respond to your letter.
